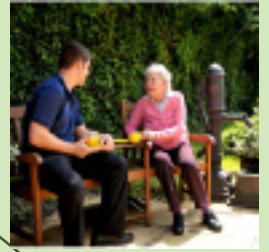


Calling Care Employers - We need your help

Acacia Training and Development Ltd will be launching a Care Work Academy as part of the government campaign "Get Britain Working" - aimed specifically at reducing levels of unemployment.

The first two weeks is spent full time at our training centre where individuals will gain a recognised qualification in preparing to work in the Care Sector.

This is followed immediately by four weeks full time work experience with a willing employer and ends with an interview by an employer (usually the same one).

You do not need to have a vacancy to offer a placement opportunity. There is no commitment on your part to offer employment.

The programme is a voluntary one and will attract short-term unemployed people who wish to learn more about working in the care sector.

Job Centre Plus advisors will be happy to explain the scheme to you and will talk you through their expectations.
